- DevOps processes with a high degree of automation and focus on quality (e.g., AWS managed services, trunk-based development, merge requests, CI/CD pipelines)
- Optionally, working with mobile technologies (e.g., react native) to wrap web experiences for native platforms

- 5+ years of experience in software engineering with a focus on front-end technologies, ideally on top of a degree in computer science or a related field (e.g., mathematics, physics)
- In depth understanding of scaled frontends (including vanilla JavaScript and node.js in browsers) and ability to work with a complex custom codebase; ideally with previous experience in performance / engagement
- Passion to understand business goals and user experiences behind software systems
- Collaborative approach to shared development with an ability to vocalize feedback and contributions to guide colleagues, and communicating with stakeholders
- Good knowledge of English; a working understanding of German is a plus
