- Definition, organization, and maintenance of test cases (e.g., via Jira / Xray) and evaluation of coverage
- Automation of back-end and front-end tests (e.g., via Chai, Mocha, Sinon, Playwright)
- Manual testing of features (e.g., via Browserstack, Developer Tools, Lighthouse, Postman) including integrations with third-party services (e.g., CMS, consent, ads)
- Creation of bug tickets in an environment based on current back-end and front-end technologies (e.g., node.js, next.js, react, TypeScript, AWS)
- Optionally, facilitating further automation of testing infrastructure, integration, and load tests (e.g., via GitLab, k6)

- 3+ years of experience in quality assurance, covering both automated and manual testing
- Ideally previous work with consumer facing applications across web and mobile platforms
- Passion to understand business goals and user experiences behind software systems
- Proactive approach to improving quality, guiding colleagues, and communicating with stakeholders
